- Unless otherwise noted, the contest specifications for all national contests are contained in the
 National SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards 2024. Be sure your instructors are
 referring to the <u>current</u> contest guidelines. The current SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards
 are available online to professional members as part of their paid membership.
- Because our state competitions are conducted in one day in contrast to the three-day national event, NJ Contest Coordinators will often post contest updates that outline any details that will differ from the published national standards. Those Contest Updates are listed on our website: www.nj-skillsusa.org.
- Several Events are held on the state level that have no national level competition. Guidelines for "NJ State Only Events" are available at www.nj-skillsusa.org. Click on States and State Only Contests.
- PS eligibility: In order to qualify to compete as a Post-Secondary competitor, students must have already graduated from high school.
- Specific contest updates will be sent directly to the advisor who is linked to the student on the contest registration site in the Advisor column.
- JOB INTERVIEW Regional Run-Offs: Job Interview Contestants should register to compete in the regional contest of their choice. The top three finalists from each region will compete for medals on April 20 at Payne Tech.
- Resumes are required for all of this years' competitors.

- Lunches will only be provided for Judges and Contest Coordinators. The only exceptions are at the Mercedes Benz and Lincoln Tech Contest sites where lunch will be provided at no expense to competitors and advisors.
- Advisors will need to make arrangements to feed their students by either packing lunches to bring
 or purchasing lunch from the lunch provider at each site. Menus will be provided ahead of time
 for the Gloucester, Sicklerville, Somerset, and Payne Tech contest sites.
- Lunches at the Carpenter Center will be provided by Kings for a price of \$10.99 for sandwich, cookie, chips and water. Individual salads will be available at the same price. Menus will be sent out ahead of time and Schools should deal directly with Kings.
- Competitors are also required to submit a completed Code of Conduct and Media Release Form along with their resume when reporting for competition. The form can be found in the Downloads tab at www.nj-skillsusa.org
- Be sure students' T-Shirt sizes are indicated in the registration system.
- In the case of inclement weather, the decision to postpone competitions will be made by noon of the day before the event.
- NJ SkillsUSA will not be providing bussing between the three April 13 competition locations.
- Schools are on their own to negotiate and book with hotels. The following hotels are prepared to
 work with you if you need overnight accommodations for your students. Mention NJ SkillsUSA
